

PROJECT STATUS

After hearing from residents at the December 3 Council meeting, the Council authorized the production of plans and specifications for the 2019 Infrastructure Improvement project. As a result, the project team has begun the final design phase for each project area. Based on input from the public during the open house, public hearing, mailed resident guide, and direct comments, various items are being adjusted to address resident concerns and other items are being further considered prior to bidding.

After the plans are complete, the Council will consider accepting plans and specs and authorizing advertisement for contractor bids. After receiving bids, the Council will review all costs and consider authorizing construction of the project. Construction will take place from May to October. In October, the Council will review all assessable costs and finalize the assessment roll.

NEXT STEPS

- Review existing street widths of adjacent streets and proposed street widths for the project. Confer with the Fire Marshal and Fire Chief related to access for emergency vehicles. Provide a best practices analysis related to on-street parking scenarios.
- Review configurations for sidewalks within the project area. The review will include an assessment of boulevard widths, setback from sidewalk to homes, and other potential impacts.
- Study traffic calming features and strategies for the downtown alley improvement.
- Review, research, and critically assess the financial inputs related to the project and past projects. Search for cost saving measures and review the Feasibility Study and Special Benefit Analysis for consistency.
- Prepare an updated project summary of recent actions, project expectations, work plan, and an anticipated project schedule for residents within the project area.
- Use data and information collected above to develop plans and specifications for the project. The City Council will approve final plans and specifications at a regular meeting. Prior to the regular meeting, draft plans and specifications will be presented in a City Council work session.

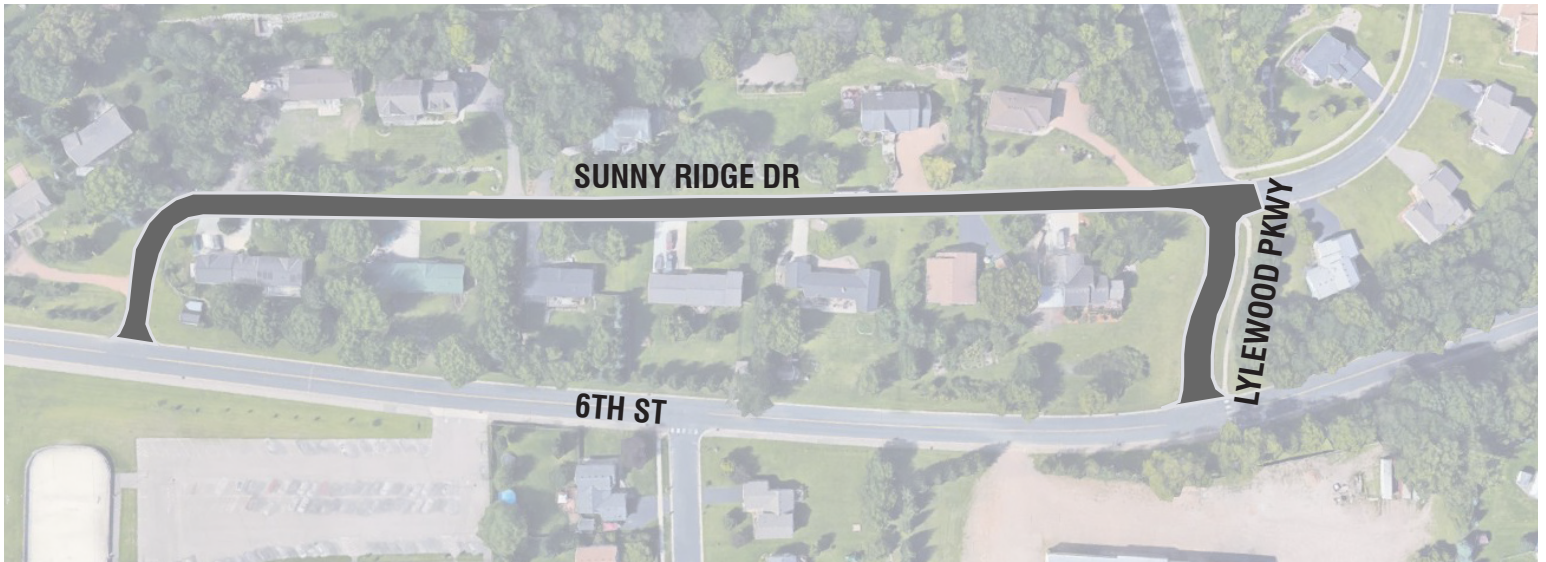
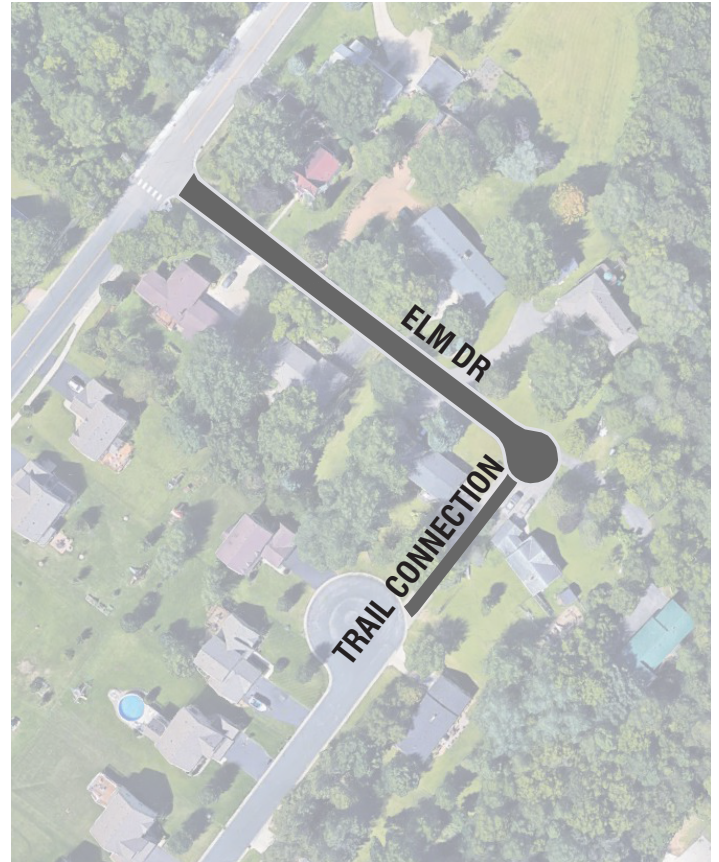
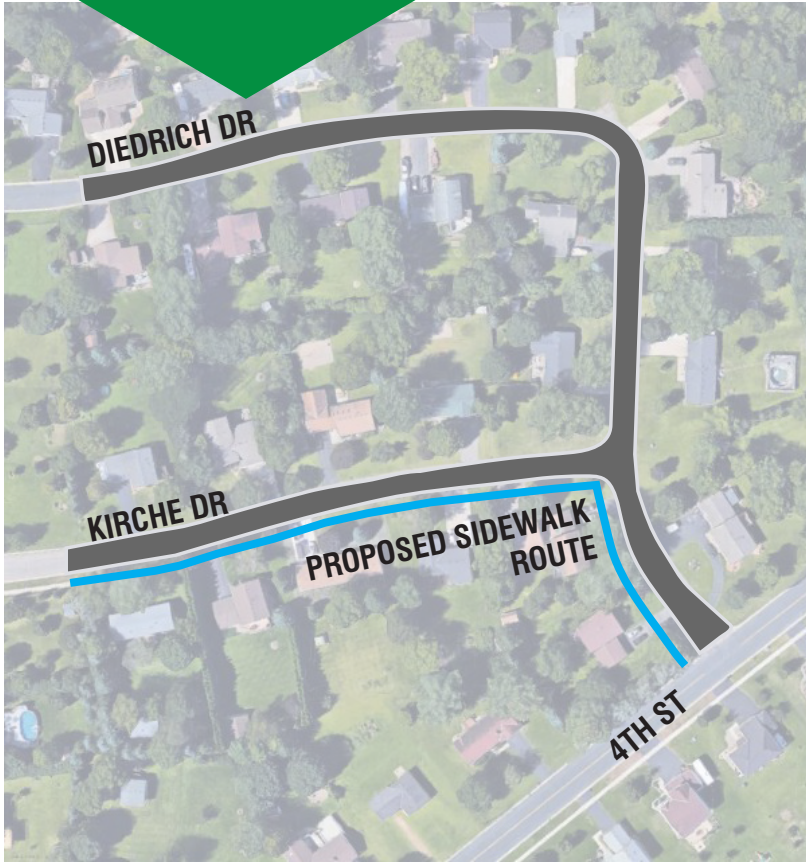
