GENERAL DISCUSSION THEMES

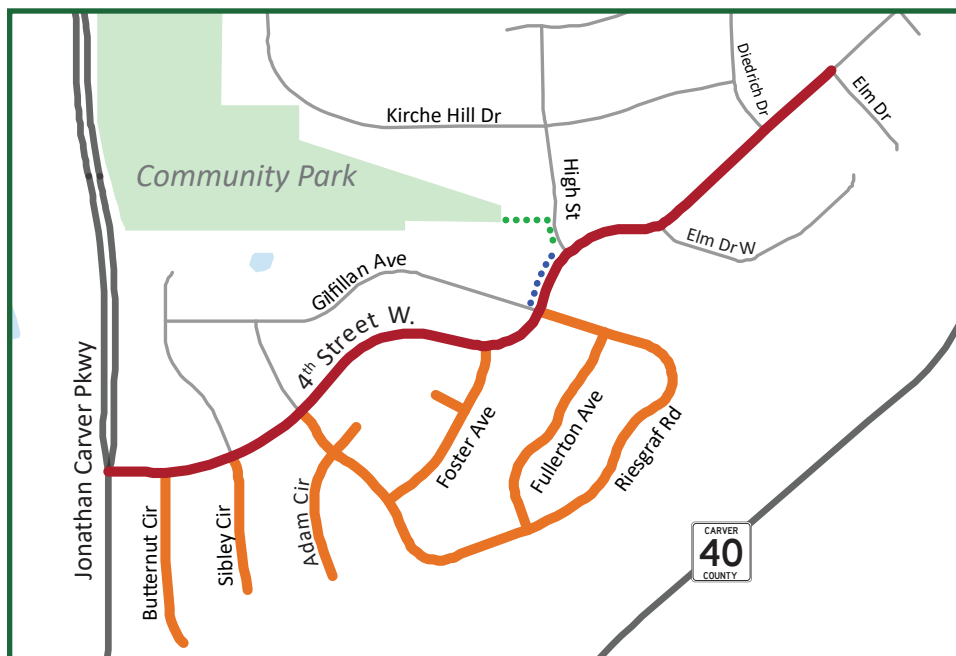
The main topics of discussions included:

- Residents noted several areas of drainage issues. These issues were recorded on the layout map for further review and investigation.
- The proposed pedestrian route connection from Community Park to 4th Street was discussed. Many options were brought up such as sidewalk vs. trail, snow removal responsibilities, crossing location on 4th Street (new uncontrolled pedestrian crossing at High Street vs. existing stop-controlled crossing at Gilfillan Ave.), pedestrian signage, etc.

RESIDENT INPUT APPLIED TO PROPOSED PROJECT DESIGN

- Addition of proposed concrete sidewalk connecting High Street and Gilfillan Ave.
- Addition of proposed asphalt trail connecting 4th Street to Community Park trail system (on the west side of High Street).
- Sidewalk crossing at controlled intersection for pedestrian safety.
