How much does it cost to use WeCAB?

All riders are encouraged to contribute! Without contributions, WeCAB cannot provide rides.

All rides are provided by *volunteer* drivers who use their personal vehicles and who have passed a background check.

WeCAB serves adults 18+ years old and who are registered WeCAB riders. WeCAB Carver does not deny rides to riders who cannot contribute.

Suggested contributions below are for one-way rides and are based on the number of miles traveled from your pick-up location to your destination.

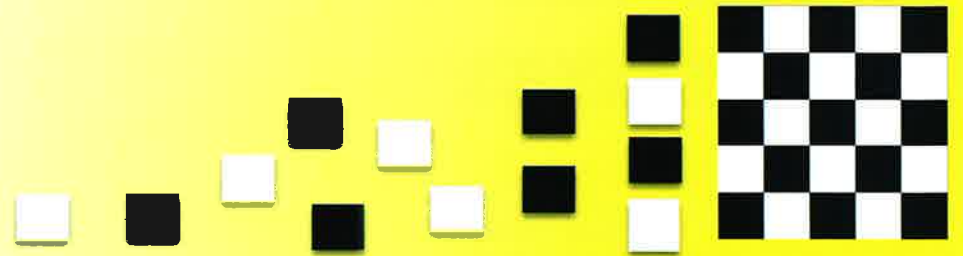

If you live within these seven cities and need supplemental transportation, we can take you where you need to go! WeCAB also has a service area that covers the Westonka area. All Ridgeview Clinic locations are considered to be in WeCAB's service area.

What we do...

WeCAB provides safe, affordable, and flexible supplemental transportation to those in Carver County's Service Areas who are unable to drive to medical appointments, grocery stores, food shelves, worship services, volunteer or social events.

When we do it...

Seven days a week, as drivers are available. Riders may request a ride between the hours of 9 am and 1 pm, Monday through Friday. For rides that are needed for Friday, the weekend, or Monday, riders should make the request by 1 pm Thursday if at all possible.

If you would like to use

WeCAB, you must be a registered rider. To become a registered WeCAB rider, please call **1-844-743-3932** and leave a message with your name and phone number. After you leave a message, a WeCAB volunteer will contact you within a week. The volunteer will explain the program and register you with WeCAB.

After you are registered (signed up), simply call the WeCAB phone number below, **between the hours of 9 am and 1 pm, Monday through Friday**, and at least 24-hours in advance, to make a reservation.
