City of Carver Ordinance – Chapter 12

Sec. 12-23 Sale of Sites.

(a) All cemetery sites shall be purchased at the city clerk's office. All sites shall be sold in consecutive order or as determined by the city. The fee amounts shall be as provided in the city fee schedule.

2021 fee schedule:

Residents of the City of Carver	\$550.00
Non-residents of the City of Carver	\$900.00
An Administrative Fee shall be charged	\$ 50.00

(b) No purchase of a cemetery site shall be considered final until the purchaser has satisfied of applicable provisions of the rules and regulations adopted by the city pursuant to section 12-37 of this chapter.

Sec. 12-32 Improvements.

(a) Fresh cut flowers, potted plants and artificial flowers are permitted from April 1 to October 31 and must be placed in a flower pot mounted on a single staked iron cemetery stand of standard size and sturdiness. Except for one single-staked iron cemetery stand, no item of any type is permitted and shall be subject to immediate removal.

(b) Evergreen wreaths and winter artificial decorations may be placed from November 1 to March 31 and must be securely staked to avoid blowing or tipping. Such winter decorations must be removed by March 31 or the city may remove and dispose of them.

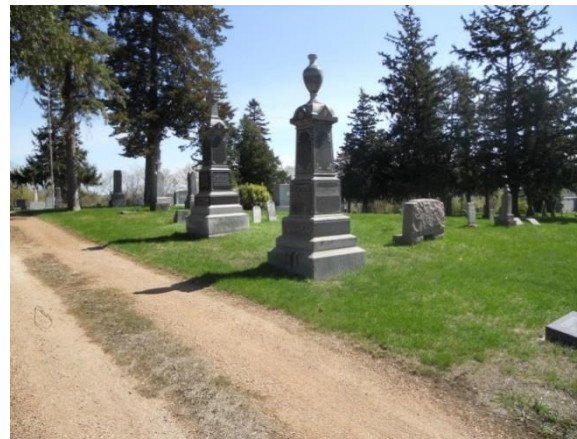
(c) No trees, vines, shrubs, annuals or perennials may be planted directly into the ground. Fences or other decorative structures or items are not permitted. The city shall not be responsible for damaged, lost or misplaced cemetery stands.

Sec. 12-36 Rights reserved to City.

The city reserves the right to remove items from a cemetery site consistent with the applicable provisions of the rules and regulations adopted by the city pursuant to section 12-37 of this chapter.

Sec. 12-37 Rules and Regulations.

Pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statute §306.025, subd. 7, the City Council is authorized and empowered to adopt and amend, from time to time, rules and regulations relating to the use and operation of Mount Hope Cemetery, which rules and regulations may be adopted by resolution.

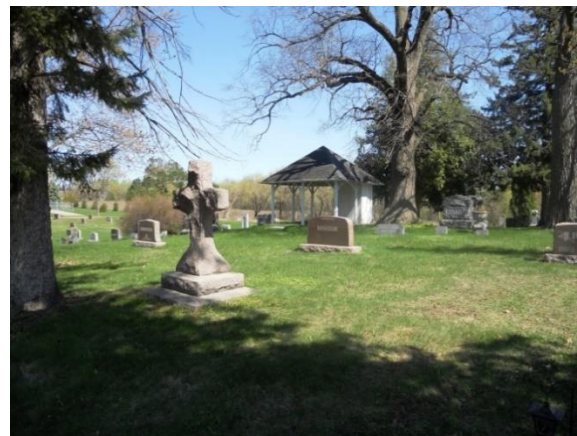


Main Entrance – Right Side
